
Decision Record (2010/11-1)

1. Rio Tinto Alcan would like to conduct repairs of the Skins Lake Spillway plunge pool. A hole in the left plunge pool training wall of the Spillway was first identified in 2007, and its size progressively increased through 2008 and 2009. In order to conduct the repairs, SLS discharge will need to be lowered to 14.3 m³/s for 3 @ 2.5 hour periods on May 18-19. This decrease in discharge will not result in any change to discharge at Cheslatta Falls and will be accounted for in the annual flow allocation.
2. The Technical Committee has considered this request in the context of the NFCP mandate and does not have an objection to this request.
